I am a Master Signature member of the Pastel Society of Colorado and a member of the Plein Air Artists of Colorado (PAAC).

Eligibility:

Entry fee:

Up to 2 pastel paintings may be submitted at a fee of \$25.00

The entry fee is non-refundable and paid at the time of entry.

Entry deadline is: August 17, 2018

Awards:

\$600+ in cash and merchandise awards. All awards are made at the discretion of our judge. All awards will be final.

ELIGIBILITY:

The, "This Place" Pastel Society of Colorado Pastel Exhibition 2018 show is open to any pastel artist

18 years of age or older.

- The PSC Exhibition Policy includes:
- Original paintings only accepted.
- No work from copyrighted images or photographs taken by anyone other than the submitting artist.
- Duplicate paintings are not accepted and will be rejected.
- If used in your paintings, collage materials must be created by the artist.
- All artwork must be at least 80% soft pastel.
- Work done under supervision in a class or workshop is not eligible.
- Paintings must have been completed within the last two years and not previously shown in any Pastel

- Society of Colorado exhibitions (with the exception of the 2017 PSC Online Show “Illuminated” and the 2018 PSC online show, “Horizons”. Paintings that were accepted into those shows are eligible so long as they have not been displayed in any other PSC shows and they have been completed within the last two years).
- Any painting identified as shown previously in a PSC exhibition will be rejected OR, if discovered after jurying, will remain in the exhibition and the artist will be suspended from the next two PSC member Exhibitions.
- The painting will also not be eligible for any awards. If artwork juried into the show is not delivered, then the artist will be prohibited from entering future PSC sponsored shows for two years.

Entry to the member show, “This Place”, gives the PSC permission to use the images for reference, printed materials, and online postings, as well as future advertising.

Make sure your information and the artwork’s information is correct, as well as pricing. This information will be used for labels when hanging the show.

Directions for entering This Place member show:

Step 1 – Go to Pastel Society of Colorado Shows and Events page www.pastelsocietyofcolorado.org/shows.php. **Go to the This Place Show Listing.**

Step 2 – Hit the **Register and Pay** button at the bottom of the This Place Listing.

Step 3 - **Fill out the Registration Form.** THIS ENTRY FORM IS CONSIDERED A CONTRACT and must be completely and accurately filled out with all requested information regarding the paintings and the artist.

Step 4 – **Prepare your images.** The images must be formatted according to the following specifications:

- File Format: jpg (jpeg) only
- File Dimensions: The image should be 1920 pixels on the longest side at 72 dpi, sRGB color space.
- Name the jpg (or jpeg) file: The file must be labeled with the first 4 letters of your last name, first 4 letters of your first name, and the entry number (i.e. David Jones 1st entry - the image file would be JoneDavi1.jpeg, the 2nd entry would be JoneDavi2.jpeg).

Step 5 – **Browse to find your images to attach them to the entry form**

Step 6 - **Submit the form** (it will send your information to thisplacechairs@pscshows.com)

Step 7 - **Enter your payment information**

Framing and Presentation:

- Artworks must be delivered framed, glazed and ready to hang to gallery standards
- Artwork does not need a mat. If a mat is used it must be white or a neutral hue
- Artwork may be floated on black or white mats
- Liners or fillets should be ¼ inch
- No saw-tooth hangers
- Artwork not meeting this standard will not be accepted

Size requirements:

The image size is no smaller than 8” on the shortest side.

Delivery of work:

Shipping:

An option for shipping for some members is to bring your artwork to the Annual meeting/Retreat in Avon, September 8, 2018. Front-range members will take the artwork to The Great Frame Up on the drop off date September 12, 2018.

The delivery dates for shipped work is September 4 -7, 2018

Include the name of the artist, address, phone number, e-mail, title of the painting, the price, on the back of your painting.

Please pack work carefully and include a pre-paid return shipping label and insure it adequately. The artist will be contacted if the work arrives damaged so that arrangements can be made to repair or re-frame. Artists are responsible for the cost of repair/reframe and will be billed directly by the framer.

Make sure to include a return shipping label as the PSC is not responsible for payment of the return shipment.

Sales:

All artwork submitted must be for sale

There will be a 35% commission and The Great Frame Up will handle all sales and sales tax.

Artists will be paid for sales within 30 days at the end of the show

Liability:

Utmost care will be taken in handling the entries. However neither the PSC nor the venue, The Great Frame Up are responsible for loss or damage. The cost of insurance is the artists' responsibility.
