Art competitions are a wonderful way to build confidence, get your artwork and name into the art community, and connect with great like-minded people. Contemporary artist Dean Mitchell credits his high school experience in local art competitions for his decision to become an artist.

AWARDS JUDGE:

The Pastel Society of Colorado is pleased to present our awards judge, **Tom Lockhart**.



Tom Lockhart is a representational landscape artist who was born and raised in the heart of the San Luis Valley of southern Colorado. Lockhart feels that solid drawing, correct values and colors, along with the atmospheric effects of light within the landscape are some of the keys to a visually stimulating and interesting image. Painting from life, en plein air as often as possible, helps to reinforce these visual stimulants when it comes to painting the landscape. Lockhart has been working as a professional artist for over thirty years. Being primarily a self-taught artist, he has learned to seek out information not only from painting from life outdoors, but also studying with top professional working artists. To help to further his knowledge and skill, he feels that nothing takes the place of study, hard work, and painting hundreds of paintings.

Several recent awards include: Top 100 Finalists in National Oil and Acrylic Painters (NOAPS), National Exhibition Showcase 2018, as well as the 2016 Online Exhibition & Merit Award Winner. Oil Painters of America (OPA) Western Regional 2017, as well as Signature membership in NOAPS, OPA, and Colorado Watercolor Society (CWS). He has gained Third Place in CWS Statewide Exhibition in 2018, and Best of Show in three Plein Air Competitions in Colorado in 2011. Lockhart was awarded Region III Silver Medal in the National Arts for the Parks in 1994 and 2004. He has been featured in Art of the West Magazine, Jul/Aug 2018, May/Jun 1998, Southwest Art Magazine 2006, and American Artists Watercolor Magazines in 2000.

ENTRY FEE/INFORMATION:

One or two (2) pastel paintings may be submitted at a fee of \$35.00. The entry fee is non-refundable and paid at the time of entry. *This show is not juried so each artist will be guaranteed a spot in the show.*

Extended Entry deadline: June 6, 2020 (midnight)

AWARDS:

\$750+ in cash awards. All awards are made at the discretion of our judge. All awards will be final.

ELIGIBILITY:

Emergence From Quarantine Member Show is open to any pastel artist that is a Member of PSC.

THE PSC EXHIBITION POLICY INCLUDES:

- Original paintings only accepted.
- Paintings must be available for sale.
- No changes to the information will be accepted after entry (title, size, price, etc)
- No work from copyrighted images or photographs taken by anyone other than the submitting artist.
- Duplicate paintings are not accepted and will be rejected.
- If used in your paintings, collage materials must be created by the artist.
- All artwork must be at least 80% soft pastel.
- Work done under supervision in a class or workshop is not eligible.
- Paintings must have been completed within the last two (2) years and not previously shown in any Pastel Society of Colorado exhibitions. Any painting identified as shown previously in a PSC exhibition will be rejected, or, if discovered after judging, will remain in the exhibition and the artist will be suspended from the next two years of PSC exhibitions. The painting will also not be eligible for any awards.

ENTRY TO EMERGENCE MEMBER SHOW:

Gives the PSC permission to use the images for reference, printed materials, and online postings, as well as future advertising. Make sure your information and the artwork information are correct, as well as pricing. This information will be used for labeling the show.

SALES:

All artwork submitted must be for sale. There will be a 10% commission to PSC. If a buyer is interested in purchasing a painting they will contact the show chairs. The show chairs will connect the buyer and artist. The sale price is part of the contract between the artist and PSC and may not be changed. The artist and buyer will negotiate the shipping costs on top of the painting price and the money transaction will be handled between the artist and buyer. The artist agrees to notify the PSC show chairs to confirm the sale was completed. The painting will be marked sold on the PSCShows.com website and PSC will invoice the artist (via PayPal) for the 10% commission.

DIRECTIONS FOR ENTERING EMERGENCE MEMBER SHOW:

Step 1: Go to PSC Shows/Events page, www.pastelsocietyofcolorado.org/shows.php. Scroll to Emergence Show Listing.

Step 2: Hit the ENTER THE EMERGENCE SHOW HERE button at the bottom of EMERGENCE listing.

Step 3: FILL OUT THE REGISTRATION FORM. This form is considered a contract and must be completely and accurately filled out with all requested information regarding the paintings and the artist.

- Be sure to enter the Painting Title(s) on the form (not the file name)

Step 4: PREPARE YOUR IMAGES. The images must be formatted according to the following specifications:

- File Format: RGB Color Space, saved as jpg (or jpeg)

- FILE DIMENSIONS: The images need to be 1920 pixels on the longest side at 72 dpi. When sizing, set the longest dimension to 1920 pixels and let the other dimension scale proportionally.

- Name the jpg FILE: The file must be labeled with the first four (4) letters of your last name, the first four (4) letters of your first name, and the entry number (i.e., David Jones 1st entry - the image file would be JONEDAVI1.jpg, the 2nd entry would be JONEDAVI2.jpg).

Step 5: BROWSE TO FIND YOUR IMAGES TO ATTACH THEM TO THE ENTRY FORM. 1 file for each entry. Please double-check to be sure your image matches your painting title!

Step 6: SUBMIT THE FORM: it will send your information to emergence@pastelsocietyofcolorado.org. Wait until your images finish uploading!

**** If your form returns with an error, please correct the fields marked in red and re-attach your images before re-submitting.**

Step 7: ENTER YOUR PAYMENT INFORMATION. You may select to pay with a credit/debit card or with your PayPal account. *There is a known PayPal issue that prevents you from paying with the credit card that is associated with your PayPal account (if you have one). If PayPal won't accept your credit card, either pay with your PayPal account or use a different credit card.*

We will accept up to 100 paintings. Each artist will get at least 1 painting in the show. 2nd paintings will be accepted first come, first serve (in the order of entries submitted) up to a total of 100 paintings.
